

Arts and Communications Career Path

Jobs in this career path usually attract persons who are creative, imaginative, innovative and original. The occupations are closely related to humanities as well as performing, visual, literary and media arts. Some related fields are architecture, interior design, creative writing, fashion design, film, fine arts, graphic design and production, journalism, languages, radio, television, advertising and public relations.

Business, Management and Technology Career Path

Jobs in this career path usually attract persons who enjoy working with numbers, organizing, developing an idea that leads to an end product, and leading others to share their skills marketing, finance, accounting, economics, management and computer/information systems.

Health Services Career Path

Jobs in this career path usually attract persons who like to care for people or animals: helping them stay well and treating them when they are sick. Related occupations deal with research, prevention, treatment and health-related technologies.

Human Services Career Path

Jobs in this career path usually attract persons who are friendly, outgoing, understanding and cooperative. They like to make life better for others by solving problems that improve the quality of life. Occupations in this path deal with economic, political and social systems. Related fields are education, government, military, law and law enforcement, leisure and recreation, delivery of goods and services, child care, social services and personal services.

Industrial and Engineering Technology Career Path

Jobs in this career path usually attract persons who are mechanically inclined and practical. They are curious about how things work, like to use their hands and build things. Occupations in this path deal with technology necessary to design, develop, install and maintain physical systems. Related fields are engineering, manufacturing, construction, service and supporting technologies.

Natural Resources/Agriculture Career Path

Jobs in this career path usually attract persons who love nature, like to be physically active while they observe, learn, investigate and solve problems related to plants and animals. They are curious about the natural world. Occupations in this path relate to agriculture, the environment and natural resources. Related fields are in agricultural sciences, earth sciences, environmental sciences, fishing, forestry, horticulture and wildlife.
